~~Things to remember~~

The presider of the wedding may be a Priest or Deacon. Because of the nature
of priestly ministry, schedules may change with very little notice. Among the
duties that Deacons are called to perform is that of blessing and celebrating the
rite of marriage.

No flash photos during the Mass.

Unity candles are NOT allowed. Memorial pictures and or candles for deceased family members may be used and will be lit before the Mass starts.

Real flower petals are NOT allowed. Artificial petals may be used on the understanding that someone must be responsible for picking them up immediately following the recessional.

The throwing of rice or bird seed is NOT permitted.

Aisle runner is NOT permitted.

No food or drinks in church!

No flowers are allowed on the main altar, they may be placed near the pillars or on the steps in front of the communion rail.

You will have approximately one hour following Mass to take pictures in the church. Confessions begin promptly at 3:00 p.m. on Saturdays and we request the church be quiet at that time.

Please remember to respect the sacred space you are in, particularly during rehearsal and photographs following the wedding.
